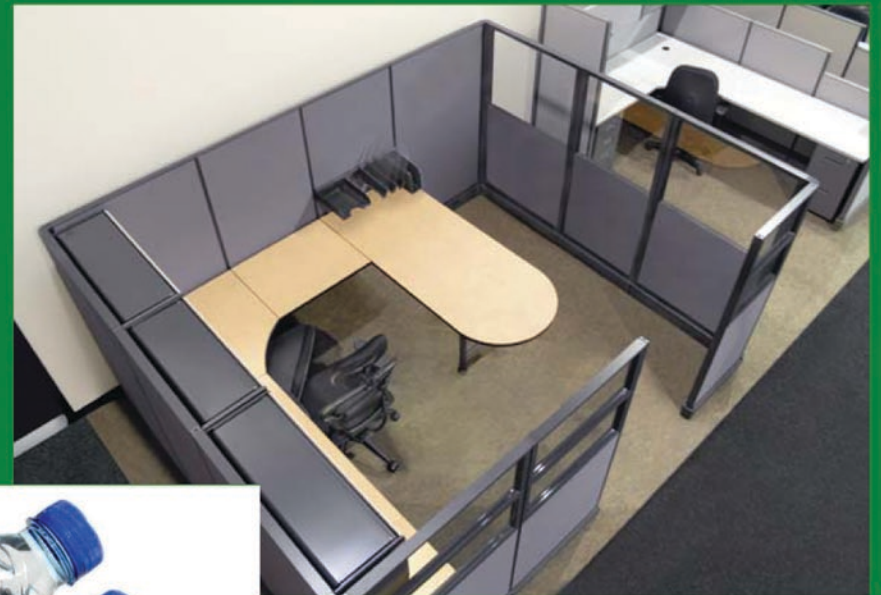


Panels & Components

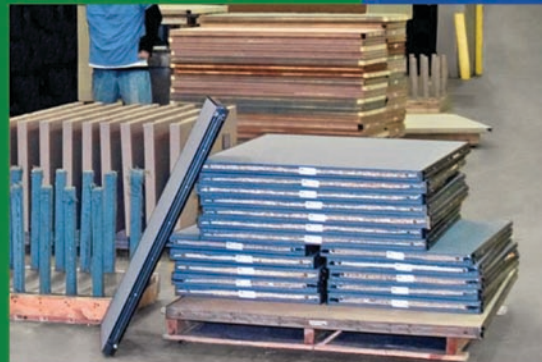
Painting

Woodworking

Scraps used for low emission fuel in a biomass oven, heating warehouse and reducing waste to land fills.

Packing

Heat sealed recyclable plastic increases protection while reducing shipping weight and packaging materials, and adding to the ease of installation.

Shipping

Old work surfaces are used for panel supports. We use recycled pallets.



Office Waste

Separated and recycled. Ink and toner cartridges recycled.



Remaining Waste

Out of 60,000 pounds we receive weekly in used furniture, only 1,000 are sent to the land fill.
